

Continuing Care Training of Trainers (TOT)

Goal: to train a cadre of Continuing Care Trainers tasked with training program staff in their jurisdiction/county on the Continuing Care level of care in funded treatment programs. Trainers will develop a local training plan and disseminate the Continuing Care training and provide technical assistance when requested as the practice assimilates into treatment.

Objectives of this TOT training:

- 1. Demonstrate thorough knowledge and understanding of the theory and mechanics of Continuing Care as a clinical practice as presented in training. Participate in prescribed activities/exercises to reinforce learning .***
- 2. Demonstrate knowledge and functionality of Continuing Care in SMART after Trainer demonstration and group discussion.***
- 3. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of basic principles of best practice training practice and technique relevant to training presentation and group discussion.***
