Initiative Description

Maryland Recovery Net utilizes state funding to expand access to a comprehensive array of community based recovery support services for Maryland residents in varying stages of recovery. **Service Menu:** Care Coordination, Housing (Halfway & Recovery Housing), Medication Assisted Therapy (for uninsured), Employment (supported & training), Transportation, Vital Documents, Recovery Coaching/Peer Services, and GAP services (medical, dental, personal care).

Target Population

- Age 18 +
- MD resident
- Substance use disorder diagnosis
- Engaged in Clinical/Recovery Services
- New service recipients only (no former ATR clients)

Service Provider Eligibility

- Attend Provider Interest Meeting
- Completed Provider Application
- Submit documentation
- Signed Provider Agreement
- Complete training (if applicable)

Provider Reimbursement

- See Service Rate Table
- Direct Deposit (now required)
- Payment within 30 days of billing

- Help Desk

- Referred by Care Coordinator/other approved referral process
