


BHA Regulations – Proposed Implementation Timeline

- New regulations will be effective September 1, 2015
- All accreditation-based programs must be accredited by December 1, 2016
- Existing ADAA and MHA community program regulations will be repealed March 1, 2017
- All programs will be required to have a license under the new BHA integrated regulations by March 1, 2017
- If an existing program applies for licensure by 12/1/16, and submits a current accreditation with the application, but BHA is unable to issue a new license prior to March 1, 2017, the existing certification or approval will be extended to the date of the issuance of a license.

Accredited Programs (continued)

Existing programs must have a license under new regulations



Non-Accredited Programs (these programs do not need to be accredited)

9/1/2015 12/1/2015 3/1/2016 9/1/2106 12/1/2016 3/1/2017

If due for renewal, must apply for new license under new BHA regulations



Deadline to submit applications for licensure under new BHA regulations in order to receive license by March 1, 2017



Must have a license under new regulations
