

Clinical Crisis Walk-In Services and Mobile Crisis Teams Survey

Senate Bill 551

As an initial step in the process to implement Senate Bill 551, which requires the development of a strategic plan for ensuring that clinical crisis walk-in services and mobile crisis teams are available statewide, the Behavioral Health Advisory Council Executive Committee has developed a survey to gather certain information from interested stakeholders and the public at-large. This survey will inform an environmental scan being performed by a consultant to the project. The questions have been designed to generate feedback related to the availability of clinical crisis walk-in services and mobile crisis teams and to help identify priorities that will be used in guiding decision-making as we work to expand these services.
