

**Attention: On June 10, 2015, ValueOptions released an Important Update to the June 5 Provider Alert. Please disregard the June 5 Provider Alert, Eligibility Re-Determination Reports, and see attached June 10 Provider Alert regarding Enhancements.**

***The two new eligibility re-determination reports that went live last week are being temporarily suspended for re-tooling. ValueOptions is working to obtain information that will be more useful to providers, including earlier visibility (2 months) from an individual's redetermination date.***

***Providers who have downloaded current versions of these reports should disregard the information. The Department and ValueOptions are working on a system re-boot to ensure that the information is as accurate and timely for providers as possible to outreach to their consumers.***
