NATURE OF WORK: This professional staff position is responsible for overseeing the Opioid Overdose Prevention initiative including the implementation of a countywide workgroup that will implement the Strategic Prevention Framework (SPF) model including needs assessment, capacity building, strategic planning, implementation and evaluation. The position will provide coordination and technical assistance of community opioid misuse prevention strategies. The position requires strong verbal and written skills. The duties of the position require experience in public speaking, use of personal computer software such as Microsoft Office, data collection and analysis, capacity building, strategic planning, and implementation of prevention programs. The position requires travel to locations within Anne Arundel County. The selected candidate must provide their own transportation and will be reimbursed for use of a personal vehicle in accordance with the Department of Health's travel reimbursement policies. The position will require evening and occasional weekend hours to staff community events and meetings.

Minimum Qualifications:

Education: Possession of a bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in public health or health education. Master's degree in public health preferred.

Experience: At least two years of professional experience in public health or health services.

Preferred Qualification: Additional consideration in the application review process will be given to applicants with two or more of the following desired qualifications.

- Anne Arundel County resident or familiarity of communities in Anne Arundel County.
- Experience working with physicians and/or pharmacists.
- Experience in data collection and analysis.
- Experience in leading community coalitions.
