

## Adolescent and Young Adults Addictions Program-

This position works with adolescents and young adults who need outpatient substance abuse treatment. Staff will have the opportunity to be part of a federal grant to provide evidence based services using the ACRA model- this is a unique opportunity to become trained and supervised in evidence based treatment and to contribute to the knowledge base of delivering evidence based services to adolescents/young adults in Maryland. This is a chance to be part of a team that will include professional staff as well as a peer recovery specialist. Services likely to be delivered combination of office based, school based, home, other community settings Strong clinical skills and experience with adolescents is needed. Computer skills required. Health occupations license ( social work or counseling) or Certification by Maryland Board of Professional Counselors in addictions is required . Minimum of a bachelor's degree is required, Master's preferred. Will consider recent Master's level's graduates who have trainee status from Maryland Board of Professional counselors. and will consider new graduates ( must have licensure or certification) with relevant internships to the qualifications.
