Vision: A community that works collaboratively to prevent substance abuse and supports recovery efforts of individuals and families.

Mission: Frederick County will coordinate a seamless system of prevention, intervention, treatment, and recovery services available to all regardless of ability to pay.

1. Continue to compile and review local data to identify emerging trends and services to be provided;
2. Develop and maintain a continuum of prevention, intervention, treatment, and recovery services;
3. Further develop a collaborative system that promotes and implements Recovery Oriented System of Care principles and elements.

GOAL I: Regularly produce and review data that reveals an accurate picture of substance abuse trends and service gaps in Frederick County.

Objective 1: Council members to semi-annually produce relevant data from sources identified above.

Objective 2: Council will review data and identify current trends and need for services to be developed and/or strengthened in Frederick County.

Goal 1 Performance Target: A composite picture of substance abuse trends, strengths, and needs in various areas of Frederick County.

Progress: To be reported as applicable every six months.

GOAL II: To develop and maintain a full continuum of prevention, intervention, treatment and recovery services accessible to all Frederick County residents (eg. Drug Court, Halfway Houses, and Co-occurring Programs)

Objective 1: Address financial issues, needs, and resource of services.

Objective 2: Expand community and provider involvement in planning and service delivery process to improve access to services.

Goal 2 Performance Target: Existing level of services is maintained or increased.

Progress: To be reported as applicable every six months.

GOAL III: To utilize ROSC principles and elements in the delivery of services in Frederick County.

Objective 1: Provide ongoing education to service providers, consumers, and community about ROSC principles and elements and how to utilize them in serving individuals and families.

Objective 2: Encourage programs to utilize consumer input regarding their implementation of services.

Objective 3: Maintain a coalition of service providers, consumers, and community members to assure collaborative efforts in serving individuals and families.

Objective 4: Develop and maintain a broad scope of available recovery services, eg. Employment services, transportation, and peer recovery coaching, in addition to treatment services.

Goal 3 Performance Target: A broad spectrum of treatment and recovery services driven by consumer input.
