

**Substance Abuse Treatment Outcomes Partnership Fund (S.T.O.P.)  
Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration  
FY2004 Report**

**A. Introduction**

The Substance Abuse Treatment Outcomes Partnership Fund (S.T.O.P.) was established by legislation (House Bill 1205) during the 2000 Session of the General Assembly and is codified as Health General Article §8-6C-01 through §8-6C-04. The intent of this Fund is to provide support for the development of new drug treatment services or the addition of new elements of treatment in an existing continuum of care. Funding is limited to local jurisdictions and requires a cash or in-kind match from the funded jurisdiction. A full or partial waiver of the match requirements may be granted by the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration (ADAA) under specific conditions.

**C. Local Match Requirements**

Under the enabling legislation, the counties are responsible for one-half the cost of approved S.T.O.P. funding. The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (the Department) is authorized to waive the match requirement under certain conditions described in Health General Article §8-6C-01 through §8-6C-04. In order to make the determination the Department must consider “the financial hardship of the participating county; prior contributions of funds for substance abuse treatment programs made by the

participating county; or other relevant considerations deemed appropriate by the Department." In making determinations regarding match requirements and requested waivers, the Department (i.e. ADA) considered the above enumerated factors and made that determination as to each county.

As shown in the Table in Section B, nineteen jurisdictions received awards under S.T.O.P. in FY2004. Of these, four provided 100% of the local match requirement (Baltimore, Prince George's Talbot, and Worcester Counties). Another six counties provided 50% or more of the local match requirement. Seven counties provided some but less than 50% of the local match requirement. Two counties (Calvert and Washington) requested and received a full waiver of the match requirements

#### **D. Program Narratives**

##### **Allegany County Health Department**

Funding was continued for staff positions for both adult and adolescent outpatient programs. The Adult program provides treatment for 45 adult slots for drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation which services 90 patients annually. The adolescent program provides treatment for 20 slots servicing 40 patients annually. The total slots funded by STOP funds are 65 providing services for 130 patients annually. In addition, the grant funds 8 slots for adolescent case management providing services to 130 patients annually. There are also 10 slots providing services to Family/Parent Education which provides services to 390 patients annually.

##### **Anne Arundel County Health Department**

Funding was provided to continue services to adolescents involved with the juvenile drug court. Funding was also provided to adults under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation. These services included Level III.5 therapeutic community, 1 slot for 3 patients, Level 1 outpatient services, 75 slots for 250 patients and Level II.1-intensive outpatient services, 2 slots for 20 patients.

##### **Baltimore County Health Department**

Funding was continued for 13 beds for medical detoxification and 28-day residential (Level III.7) at Hilltop Recovery Center on the grounds of Rosewood center. The beds were fully utilized in fiscal year 2004. A total of 300 patients who were drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation or parents of children at risk of entering out-of-home placement received 28-day residential treatment.

##### **Calvert County Health Department**

Funding was provided to continue services for Level III.5 therapeutic community, 10 adult slots for 15 patients. The services are for adult drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation. Services were purchased from Calvert County Treatment Facility.

### **Carroll County Health Department**

Funding was continued for Junction, Inc. rapid intake unit to enable treatment on demand for adolescents. The rapid intake unit completes patient assessments and refers patients to the appropriate treatment modality within two weeks of the initial contact. A total of 200 patients were assessed in FY 2004. The grant also funds 8 treatment slots in the Level II.5 Jail Based Program providing services to the general inmate population within the county detention center serving 30 patients annually.

### **Cecil County Health Department**

Funding was provided for 65 slots of Level I outpatient services for the general inmate population within the Cecil County Detention Center. A total of 121 patients were served in FY'04

### **Charles County Health Department**

Funding was renewed to continue services at Jude House for Level III.3 long-term residential for 22 slots to serve annually 66 patients. These slots are reserved for clients who are drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation. Funding was also continued for Level I –Jail Based services, 15 slots the general inmate population in the Charles County Detention Center providing services for 60 patients.

### **Dorchester County Health Department**

Funding was provided for Level III.3 long term residential services 10 slots for 21 patients who are drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation.

### **Frederick County Health Department**

Continuing STOP funding supported 30 adult who are drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation, and 35 adolescent treatment slots in Level I Outpatient services providing treatment services to 231 patients annually. In addition, funding was available for 45 slots in the Level II.1 Jail Based Services program providing services to 192 patients in the general inmate population of the county correctional facility annually.

### **Garrett County Health Department**

Funding provided for the services of a full-time contractual addictions counselor to work in cooperation with the county board of education in the delivery of adolescent intervention services. A total of 35 patients were served.

### **Harford County Health Department**

Continued STOP funding was awarded for the community re-entry program (“RAP”) for drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation. The RAP program provided 65 slots for Level I outpatient services to 165 patients in fiscal year 2004. Level 1 outpatient adolescent services were provided, 24 slots to 30 patients in fiscal year 2004. Also, \$75,000 was awarded for services to general inmate population of the Harford County Detention Center.

**Howard County Health Department**

Funding was awarded for Level III.1 halfway house services for drug offending men under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation, 12 slots for 15 patients.

**Prince George's County Health Department**

Funding was provided for adolescent drug court case management services for 100 patients. Continued funding provided 75 Level 1 adolescent outpatient slots for 150 patients.

**Saint Mary's County Commissioners**

Funding was provided for 10 slots for women and their children receiving temporary cash assistance at the Compass Halfway House Level III.I. Funding was also used for psychiatric services and psychotropic medication for patients receiving temporary cash assistance residing at the Marcy House Level III.I halfway house.

**Somerset County Health Department**

Continued funding supports the Courage to Change Program serving the general inmate population at the Somerset County Detention Center. The program incorporates an anger management component as well as education about HIV, sexually transmitted diseases and hepatitis, In FY'04, 51 patients were admitted into the program with 105 individual and group services provided

**Talbot County Health Department**

Continued funding, supported 30 Level I outpatient treatment slots for drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation, as well as screening, assessment, case management, and aftercare for addicted offenders in the general inmate population of the Talbot County Detention Center. In FY'04, 39 patients were served.

**Washington County Health Department**

The grant funded 8 slots in the Level III.3 Long Term Residential Services for Women and Children receiving temporary cash assistance at the Cameo House. This allowed up to 16 women to receive services along with their children.

**Wicomico County Health Department**

Funding supported Level I outpatient services in the general inmate population of the Wicomico County Detention Center 45 slots for 101 patients.

**Worcester County Health Department**

Funding in the Worcester County Detention Center supports psychiatric consultation services for co-occurring individuals in the general inmate population, and assessment / case management services for adolescents involved in the criminal justice system. In FY'04, 30 Level I outpatient adult slots for drug offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation; 5 outpatient co-occurring adult slots, and 10 Level II.1 intensive outpatient adult based slots for the general inmate population of the Worcester County Detention Center. Psychiatric assessments were provided to 160 adult drug

offenders under the supervision of the Division of Parole and Probation and 75 adolescent patients.

**In Conclusion** – The Alcohol and Drug Abuse Administration does not produce separate performance and outcome indicators for individual funding sources. The ADAA awards funding to the jurisdictions as a combination of State, Federal, Special and Reimbursable Funds. The following applicable MFR performance measures included in this report address the agency goal to provide a comprehensive continuum of effective substance abuse treatment services with emphasis on access to treatment and retention in treatment.
